DOWNTOWN AUSTIN ALLIANCE 2006 IMPACT AWARDS

Nomination Deadline: Friday, August 18, 2006 by 12:00 Noon.

Entries applications must include the following:

1. Entry Form

2. Project Summary/Narrative (no more than 1 page total)

- Overview of the project, reason for nomination, including innovations, any exemplary solutions to problems encountered and overcome, unique design applications (for design entries), green building features, etc. and completion date.
- Impact Statement - a description and/or qualified analysis of the impact of the project on Downtown and any potential "ripple" effect. (See criteria sheet)
- Participants - List all participants/partnerships and their contributions to the project.
- Funding - (if applicable) a description of cost of project and funding sources, primarily for public projects.

3. Digital Images

- Six (6) to ten (10) digital images are required. All images must be labeled properly with all pertinent photo credit information. (Note: With submission of images, it is understood that these may be used in the Alliance's annual report and/or "Downtown Focus" newsletter for IMPACT Award purposes.)

4. Supplemental Materials

- Additional supplemental or graphic materials (no more than five (5) double-sided pages) that help to describe the project, individual or organization are welcome and encouraged, but not necessary.

5. Video/DVD

- If available or applicable, VHS or DVD materials may also be submitted for review.

6. Additional copies – Please submit one original copy of the entry packet and 10 photo copies.



2006 DOWNTOWN IMPACT AWARDS CATEGORY SHEET

The IMPACT Awards are given to individuals, organizations or projects that are "larger than themselves," having a dramatic and positive effect on the Downtown community, and even its surrounding neighborhoods.

Individual or Organization

Nominations may be made for any individual or organization that has made a significant contribution to Downtown Austin, thereby enhancing the economic, cultural, social and/or physical well being of the Downtown community.

Project

Nominations may be made for any project that has made a significant contribution to Downtown Austin, thereby enhancing the economic, cultural, social and/or physical well being of the Downtown community.

Strong consideration will be given to nominations whose efforts or presence inspire desirable "ripple" effects throughout the Downtown community including, but not limited to, new development, historic preservation or creative reuse of a building or site, public art, and new services or programs.

Design

Design Award nominations may be made for any design project that has made significant contributions to Downtown Austin thereby enhancing the economic, cultural, social and/or physical well being of the Downtown community. Design Award nominations may include, but are not limited to, architecture, interior and exterior restorations and renovations, art, streetscapes, and public spaces.

Chair Emeritus Award

The Chair Emeritus Award will be selected by the Alliance's immediate past Chair of the Board of Directors and may be given to any person, place, thing, or event that the Chair Emeritus wishes to specially recognize. Suggestions for nominations will be considered, with the ultimate decision being made by the immediate past chair.

The IMPACT Awards Committee reserves the right to move entries from one submitted category to another, or modify categories if nominees of sufficient merit are submitted.
