



When interpreting data, considerations to keep in mind are regularly occurring large events that may bring into the downtown area an influx of people such as: Free Week (January), SXSW (March), Hot Summer Nights Music Festival (July), Austin City Limits Music Festival and Formula 1 Racing (October), etc.


Increased rates observed during more active months may be attributed to an increased presence of enforcement (i.e., focused, strategic efforts are likely to lead to an increase in response = increased reports = increased count / rate)

#### NOVEMBER 2023 – NOVEMBER 2024

Overall, rates appear to be relatively stable; with 2024 trending similarly to 2023. Notably, efforts to increase officer presence are in place so any observed differences may be attributed to increased visibility.

MAP: All Persons Crimes November 2023 – November 2024






#### NOVEMBER 2024

Two clusters are identified based on overall density. Activity appears to be largely clustered east of Congress Ave.


#### NOVEMBER 2023 – NOVEMBER 2024

Data indicates that 2024 is trending similarly to 2023, overall. Rates are down, overall, from November 2023 to November 2024 – which is likely attributed to focused action by officers.






#### NOVEMBER 2023 – NOVEMBER 2024

Overall, rates appear to be relatively stable; with 2024 trending similarly to 2023. Data indicates that counts across all three offense types decreased from October to November 2024. This is likely attributed to the activation of the light towers in October 2024 – which were placed strategically in various spots on the East side of the sector.






#### **Total Downtown Estimated Unsheltered Homeless**


