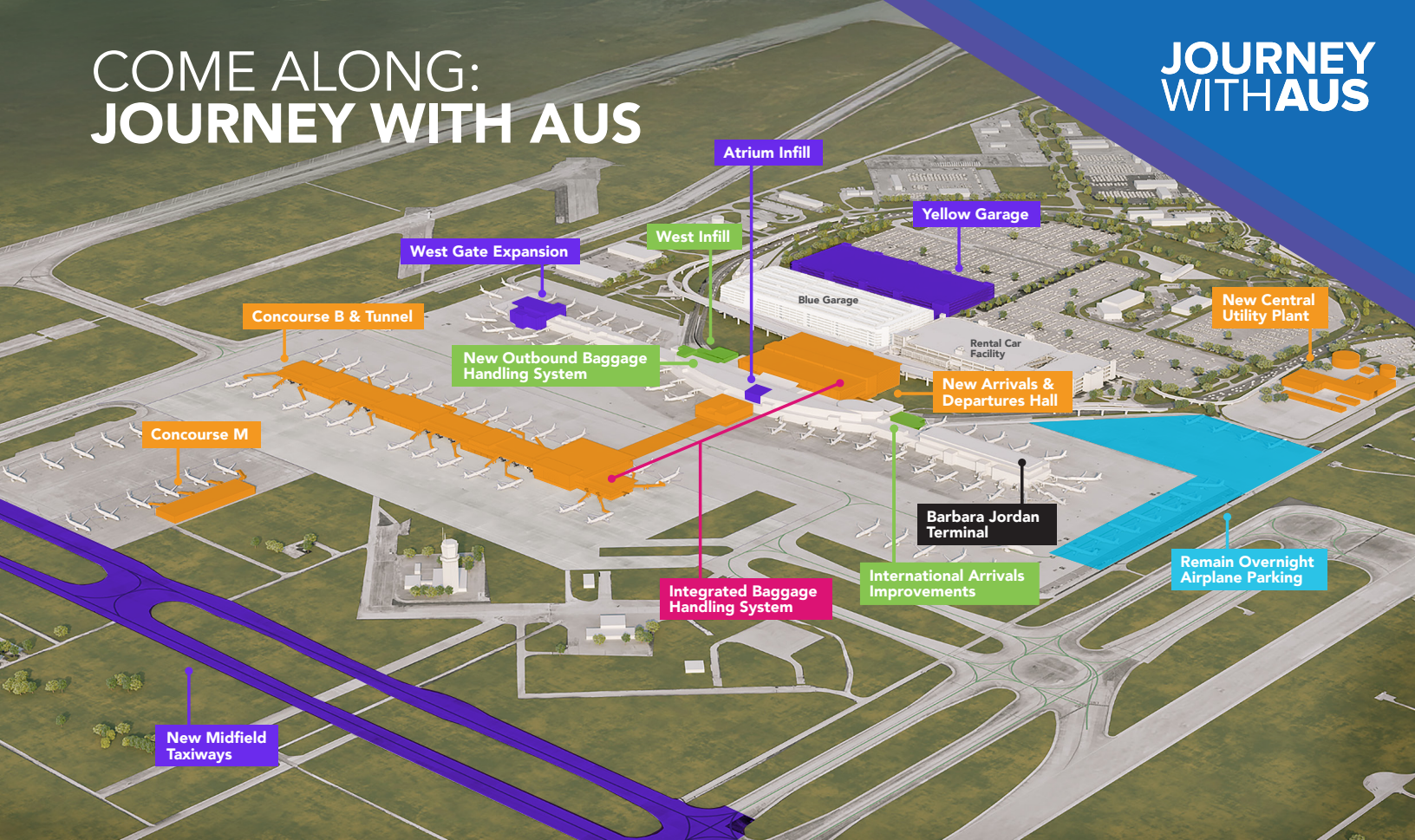

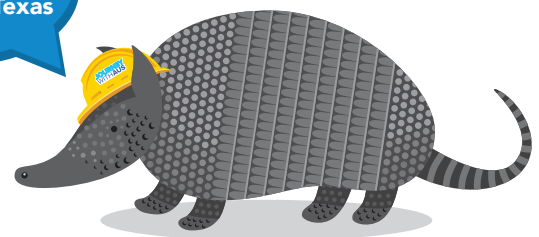
Five-phase process: **ENVISION** **PROCUREMENT** **DESIGN** **BUILD** **ACTIVATE**

Near-term projects

West Gate Expansion

A terminal expansion adding a total of 84,500 square feet across the apron, concourse, and mezzanine levels. This facility will provide additional restrooms, waiting areas, a quiet space, and three new gates to offset future construction-related closures.

Phase: **BUILD**
Estimated completion: 2026

Atrium Infill

This project will add more than 12,000 square feet of floor space on the departure level for security screening and passenger queuing. This project is also a key part of the airport's future layout.

Phase: **BUILD**
Estimated completion: 2026

Enabling projects

New Midfield Taxiways

Two parallel midfield taxiways will provide connectivity between the east and west side of the airport when the existing midfield taxiways are removed to build Concourse B.

Phase: **BUILD**

Estimated completion: 2027

New Central Utility Plant

A new plant will meet the cooling and heating demands of expansion projects. Other utility projects include a new Austin Energy substation, stormwater drainage and water quality ponds, power supply, electrical duct banks, communication systems, and FAA duct bank.

Phase: **DESIGN**

Estimated completion: 2028



Long-term expansion projects

Integrated Baggage Handling System

An expansion of the baggage handling system will be necessary to support the new Concourse B and the New Arrivals & Departures Hall.

Phase: **PROCUREMENT**

Estimated completion: Early 2030s

Concourse B & Tunnel

A new midfield concourse will connect to the existing Barbara Jordan Terminal through an underground tunnel. The project will include all passenger and tenant spaces like new concessions, airline lounges, at least 26 new gates, and increased aircraft parking.

Phase: **DESIGN**

Estimated completion: Early 2030s

New Arrivals & Departures Hall

A new hall will expand ticketing and check-in, consolidate TSA checkpoints, and add more space for concessions and tenants. This will require the removal of the existing Red Garage and relocation of the current curbside roadway.

Phase: **DESIGN**

Estimated completion: Early 2030s

Yellow Garage

A new, approximately 7,000 space, multilevel parking garage will be built north of the Blue Garage. Improvements also include a pedestrian bridge to the Blue Garage and dedicated entrance and exits.

Phase: **BUILD**

Estimated completion: 2027

Concourse M

This facility will add six temporary gates that allow for six narrow-body aircraft, and will be separate from the Barbara Jordan Terminal to allow for expansion construction. Once the gates are no longer needed, it will turn into a belly freight facility.

Phase: **DESIGN**

Estimated completion: 2027



Funding

Local Austin taxpayer dollars are not being used to fund the program. Funding comes from traditional airport development sources such as airport cash reserves, current and future airport revenues, future revenue bond proceeds, and FAA grants. The airport has funding dedicated to the program and plans to raise additional funds through FAA grants and future airport revenues, which are determined by airline use and lease agreements.



Airline involvement

At the beginning of 2026, the airport and its airline partners signed a new agreement that established the financial and operational framework for how passenger airlines and cargo companies will operate at AUS for the next decade. These agreements provide the financial foundation for airport-generated revenue to support ongoing operations and fund the airport's expansion and development.
